Ayrshire exhibitors: Alternate leadspersons must be (1) siblings of the exhibitor who are eligible to show by age, OR (2) if not a sibling, be of the same age category (Junior – ages 9-12) (Intermediate- ages 13-15) (Senior – ages 16-21) as the exhibitor of the animal being shown. All ages are as of January 1 of the year of competition. Milking Shorthorn exhibitors: Alternate Leadsperson must be a National Milking Shorthorn Junior member who is the same age or younger or up to three years older than the owner or who is a sibling (full, half, step, foster) of the owner. All Alternate Leadspersons must meet the junior age requirements of a minimum of nine years old but not have reached their 21st birthday by January 1 in the year competing.
